When people think of ETSU women's basketball the first thing that comes to mind is head coach **Karen Kemp**, as she is set to enter her 16th season at the helm for the Lady Bucs. Since taking over the program in 1994, Kemp has posted 214 career wins, giving her the most wins in school history. Once again Kemp's Lady Buccaneer squad made history in 2008-09, as ETSU made its second straight NCAA Tournament appearance after winning the 2009 Atlantic Sun Conference Tournament. In addition, under Kemp's watch, the Lady Bucs also posted their third straight 20-win season and fourth consecutive winning season. Kemp, the 2008 Atlantic Sun Coach of the Year, also achieved an important milestone in 2008-09, as she won her 200th career game with a 75-67 win at Florida Gulf Coast back on Jan. 8. Meanwhile, Kemp coached Siarre Evans to the 2009 Atlantic Sun Player of the Year honor - marking the fourth player in her tenure to receive this special award. In total, four Lady Buccaneer players received all-conference accolades this past season - including 2009 Defensive Player of the Year Latisha Belcher. In total, Kemp has now guided the Lady Bucs to three straight postseason tournament appearances and all four of their postseason berths. In 2007-08, Kemp's club made history by winning the 2008 Atlantic Sun regular season and tournament championships, which marked the first time in Lady Buccaneer history the team was represented in the NCAA Tournament. The 2007-08 squad accumulated numerous accolades, as four ETSU student-athletes as well as coach Kemp won Atlantic Sun postseason awards. Kemp was tabbed Coach of the Year by her peers for the second time in her career and her team also achieved high standards in the classroom, by having five Lady Bucs named to the Atlantic Sun All-Academic Team.
