Proceed West on Interstate 26/US-23N. Take exit 24 for US-321/TN-67. Turn Left onto University Parkway. (Travel 2 miles) Turn Left at State of Franklin Road. (Travel 1/2 mile) Turn Left at John Robert Bell Drive.

FROM KNOXVILLE, TN

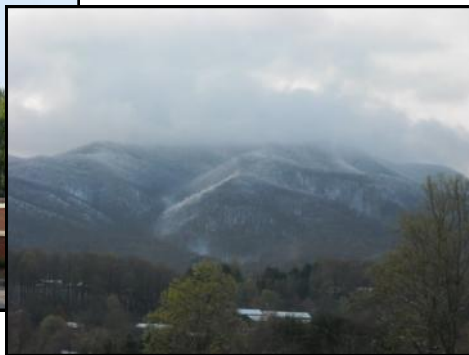
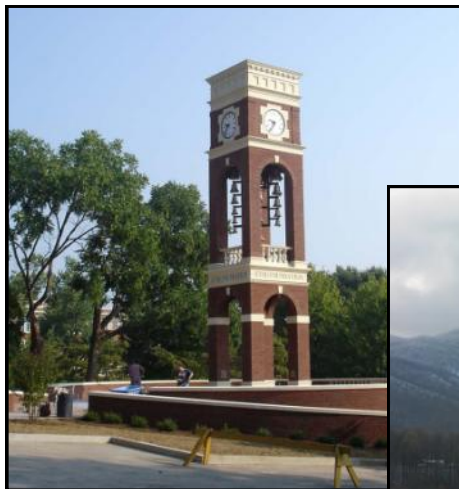
(Approx. 106 miles—1 hour, 45 minutes)

Proceed East on Interstate 40. Merge Left onto Interstate 81 (I-81 N/Bristol). Take Exit 57A, merging onto Interstate 26 E/US-23 S. (Travel 10.5 miles) Take Exit 19 for TN-381/State of Franklin Road. Turn Right onto N State of Franklin Road/TN-381 S. (Travel 5 miles) Turn Right at John Robert Bell Drive.

(Approx. 185 miles—2 hours, 50 minutes)

Proceed South on Interstate 81 Toward Salem/Bristol. Take Exit 57A, merging onto Interstate 26 E/US-23 S. (Travel 10.5 miles) Take Exit 19 for TN-381/State of Franklin Road. Turn Right onto N State of Franklin Road/TN-381 S. (Travel 5 miles) Turn Right at John Robert Bell Drive.

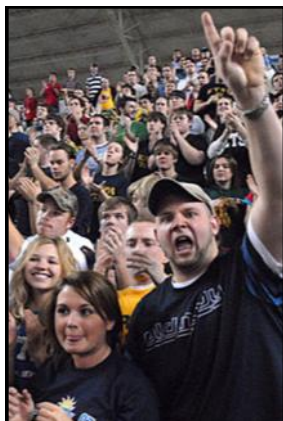

MOUNTAIN STATES HEALTH ALLIANCE ATHLETICS CENTER

Men's and Women's Basketball

The MSHA Athletics Center is the dominant architectural landmark of Johnson City and the ETSU Campus. Construction began on the Dome in 1973. It took four years and \$8.3 million to complete, opening its doors on September 10, 1977. The height of the

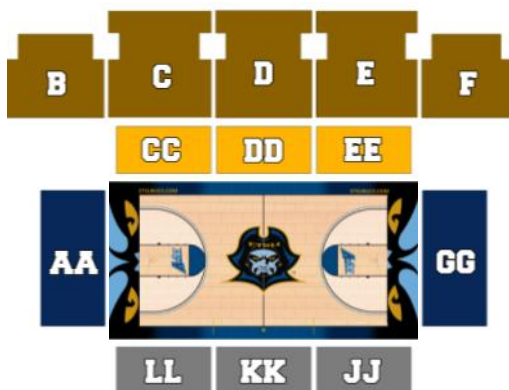
Dome arch stands at 121 feet above floor level, and the roof covers 184,000 square feet of space, with an 87,300 square foot floor level. Aside from the main floor area, the dome contains two auxiliary basketball courts, a six-lane track, six racquetball courts, six tennis courts, a rifle range, batting cage, strength training facility, kinesiology/sport science research laboratory, and numerous locker rooms. The Dome hosts events for basketball, indoor track and indoor tennis; and was the previous home of the school's rifle and football programs. The Dome also serves as an indoor practice facility for baseball, softball, and soccer; and hosts numerous concerts and other special events during the year including the NAIA Indoor Track and Field National Championship.

POLICIES & PROCEDURES

- Gates open one hour prior to tipoff
- Ticket booths are located on the west side of the Dome
- All entrances located on west side of the facility
- Will call is located at the top of the west ramp on the upper concourse
- Tickets required for everyone ages 3 and up
- Parking is located in lots to the west, south, and east of the facility
- Outside food or drink is not permitted

SUMMERS-TAYLOR STADIUM

Men's and Women's Soccer

Completed in 2009, for a cost of \$4.4 million, Summers-Taylor Stadium features one of the finest natural playing surfaces in the southeast. The stadium boasts seating for 1,000 with additional seating available on the open berm area on the east end of the stadium. Fans have flocked to the new venue, and tailgating is a premier draw in parking lots to the north of the facility overlooking the field.

POLICIES & PROCEDURES

- Gates open one hour prior to game time
- Ticket booths are located at the gates on both ends of the stadium
- Tickets are \$7 and \$5 and required for everyone ages 3 and up
- Buses may unload at the north end of the stadium on Jack Vest Drive
- Parking is also located on the north end of the stadium on Vest Drive
- Outside food or drink is not permitted

BUCCANEER PARK

Baseball

The new home of ETSU Baseball is projected to make its anticipated opening during the 2012 season. The 500+ seat stadium will also feature picnic-style hillside seating along the baselines, a state-of-the-art Daktronics LED video board, TV-quality lighting, modern concessions and restroom facilities, and a FieldTurf™ playing surface. Unique to the Buccaneer Park experience is the University Edge student condominiums, with apartment balconies that overlook left field and the Blue Ridge Railroad which borders the right field fence

POLICIES & PROCEDURES

- Gates open two hours prior to first pitch, remain open through the middle of the 5th Inning
- Tickets are available at main gate, which is located on corner at the entrance to University Edge.
- Tickets required for everyone ages 3 and up
- Outside food/drink is not permitted
- Parking is located adjacent to the stadium along University Parkway.

BETTY BASLER FIELD

Softball

The newest facility in ETSU's lineup is Betty Basler Field. Located on the corner of Greenwood Drive and Ashley Road, the new 500-seat facility offers picturesque views of the mountain range near campus and seats near the top of the facility overlook campus and downtown Johnson City. The main playing field measures 200 feet around the entire dimensions of the fence.

POLICIES & PROCEDURES

- Gates open 1 hour prior to first pitch
- Tickets are available at the main gate plaza
- Tickets required for everyone ages 3 and up
- Outside food or drink is not permitted
- Parking is located in lots surrounding the facility, overflow parking is located across Ashley Road next to the train tracks. Parking is NOT permitted in the apartment complex across the street
- A designated bus loading/unloading area is located to the right of Greenwood Drive, across from Jack Vest Drive. Teams are asked to walk up the stairs and into the stadium





FACILITIES

J. MADISON BROOKS GYMNASIUM

Volleyball

Completed in 1950 to originally house basketball, stately J. Madison Brooks Gymnasium is now exclusively home to the ETSU Volleyball program. The 2,700-seat facility also contains a lower-level auxiliary gymnasium, indoor pool, and a stage area. The front of the building contains office and classroom space, with the second floor housing the ETSU Bluegrass Music program, and the main floor housing the U.S. Army ROTC offices. The Theatre department's costume and set design shop can also be found in the basement of Brooks Gym. The arena floor of Brooks Gym was resurfaced prior to the 2009 season. A renovation of the entire main arena was completed in summer 2010. Among the upgrades are refurbished seats, fresh paint, and updated lighting, a new sound system, new scoreboards, new doors and windows and the installation of a new heating and air-conditioning system.



POLICIES & PROCEDURES

- Gates open one hour prior to game time
- Tickets sold only at main entrance on east side of building
- Tickets are \$5 and required for everyone ages 3 and up
- Outside food/drink is not permitted
- Bus Parking located directly behind the facility on Bell Drive





DAVID E. WALKER TRACK and GENTRY FIELD

Indoor Track and Field

Located inside the MSHA Athletics Center, Walker Track and Gentry Field play host to three main competitions each year. The Niswonger Invitational is a dual-meet event bringing the best in collegiate and club track athletes to Johnson City. The Niswonger meet now includes a high school element in partnership with the Knoxville Track Club. ETSU is also host to the Atlantic Sun Indoor Track and Field Championships in February, and Johnson City hosts the NAIA Indoor Track and Field National Championship each March.

POLICIES & PROCEDURES

- Gates open to public one hour prior to first scheduled event
- Participant registration located on west side lower level
- Warm-up area located in west auxiliary gym



BUDDY HARTSELL COURTS

Men's and Women's Tennis

Completed in 1990, the courts are named after former ETSU tennis coach Buddy Hartsell. The ETSU Buddy Hartsell Tennis Center features nine outdoor courts that serve as the home of both the 14-time conference champion men's tennis team, in addition to the

three-time league champion Lady Buc squad. Overall, the Buddy Hartsell Tennis Center features outdoor lighting, a state-of-the-art speaker system and courts which were resurfaced in the summer of 2005. The venue has hosted numerous special events in the past 20 years. Most recently, it served as host of the 2007, 2008 and 2009 Atlantic Sun Conference men's and women's tennis championship tournaments.






CAMPUS MAP

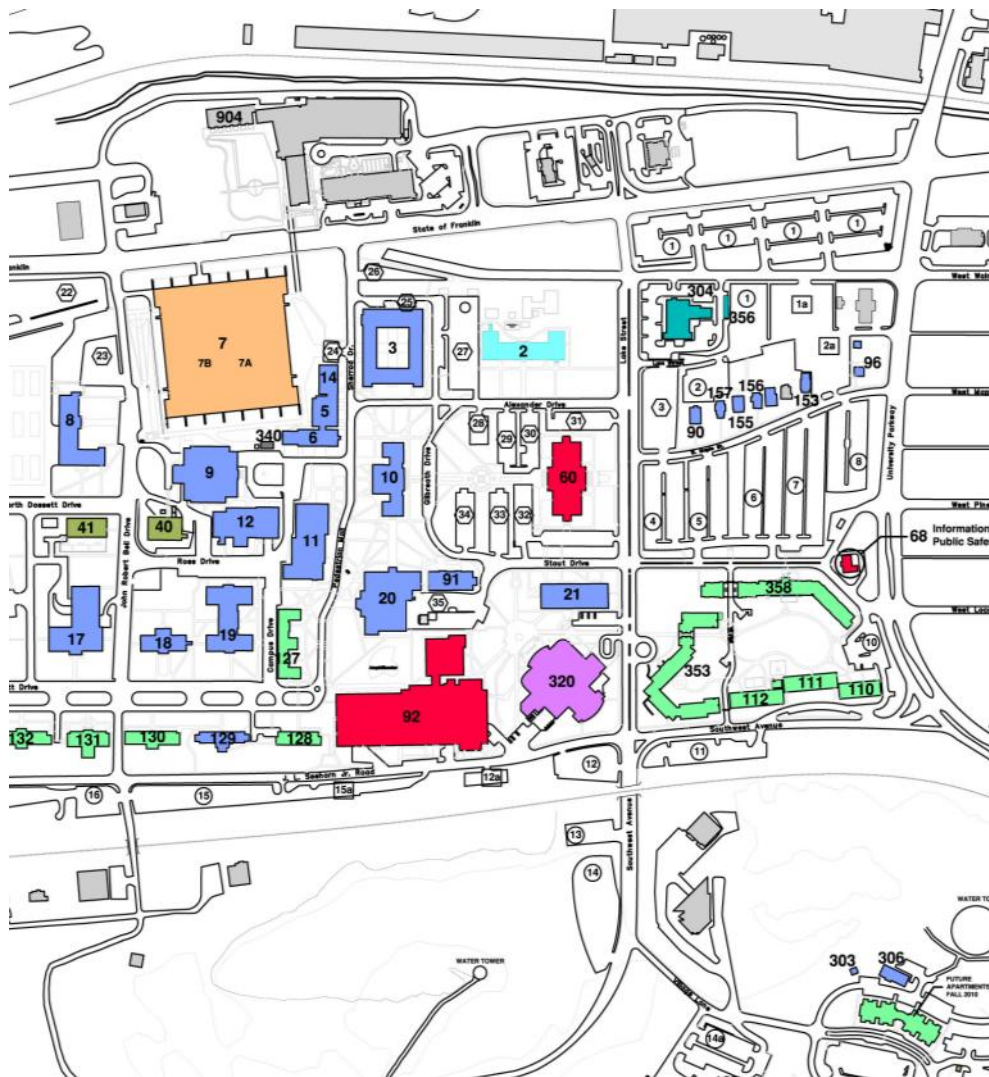

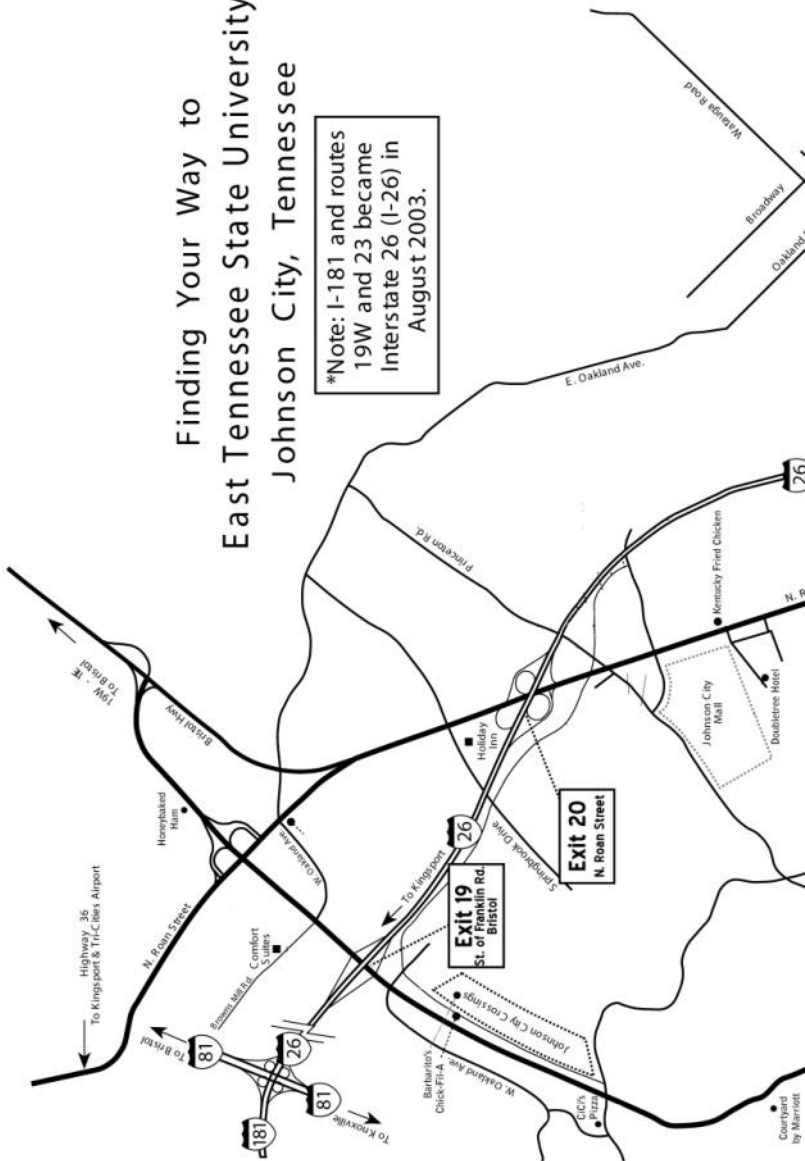




LOCAL MAP

BucSports is located in the southwest corner of the Memorial Center in a 7,500 square-foot facility offering a comprehensive program specializing in the diagnosis, treatment, prevention, and rehabilitation of injuries. BucSports is staffed by a conglomeration of medical professionals equipped with the latest in sport medicine technology.
