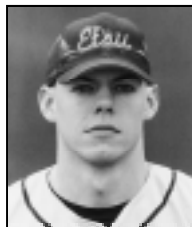
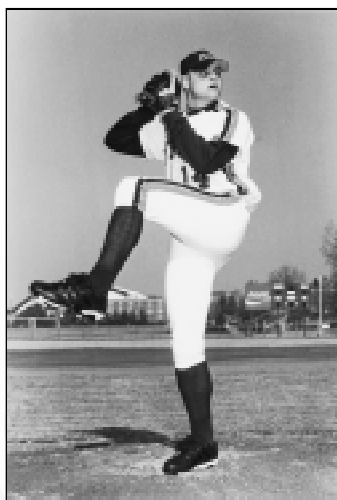


BUCS IN THE PROS IN 2002



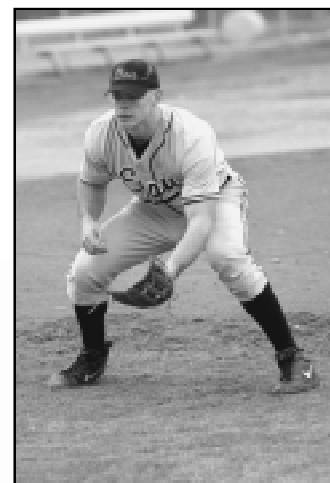
Matt Baber
1999-2000

Played for the Washington Wildthings of the independent Frontier League in 2002. Posted an 8-7 record with a 3.63 ERA in 18 starts. Baber struck out 74 batters in 111.2 innings pitched and had two shutouts and three complete games on the season.



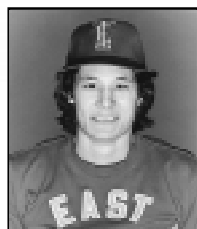
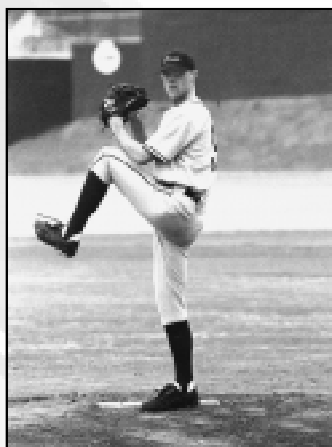
Andy Baxter
2001

After being named an Appalachian League All-Star in 2001, the Cleveland Indians promoted Baxter to the Mahoning Valley Scrappers of the New York-Penn League in 2002. Baxter played in 64 games for the Scrappers last season, batting .252 with four home runs and 32 RBIs. He also tied for second on the team with 13 stolen bases.



Reid Casey
1999-2002

Reid played in the Cleveland Indians organization for the Burlington Indians of the Appalachian League in 2002. He worked primarily as a reliever, recording a 3.46 ERA in 17 games. He fanned 46 batters in 41.2 innings pitched.



Atlee Hammaker
1976-78

Played 12 years in the major leagues with four teams, seeing most of his action with the San Francisco Giants. Started the 1983 All-Star game. Posted a career record of 59-67 with a 3.66 ERA.

- Nathan Copeland (1999-01)** - Copeland played in the Atlanta Braves organization in 2001, playing for the Danville Braves of the Appalachian League.
- Adam Cross (1992-95)** - Spent time in both the San Diego Padres and Atlanta Braves organizations as an infielder.
- Len Hart (1993-96)** - Spent five years in the San Diego Padres organization, last playing with the Mobile Baybears (AA).
- Ed Sparks (1997-2000)** - A catcher, he played for the Billings Mustangs before being promoted to the Dayton Dragons (AA) in 2000 after being drafted by the Cincinnati Reds.
